June 10- Monthly KECB meeting beginning at 5:30 in our office. All are invited.

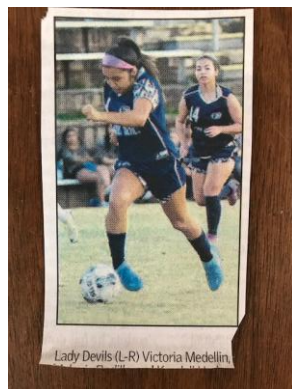
June 14- Recycling event at the Elberton Recycling Center.
